VACCINE (Trade Name)	Doses on Hand	Doses Required
Tdap – Adacel® or Boostrix® – Adults who are due for a Td booster should receive 1 dose of Tdap vaccine.		
Pneu-C-20 – Pneumococcal 20 (Pneumovax 20™)		
TB – Tubersol® – Tubersol will be provincially funded for the following situations only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To screen contacts of cases of active tuberculosis to assess for possible transmission - To screen new immigrants in accordance with directives from Citizenship and Immigration Canada - To screen people for whom it is deemed medically necessary, including those who are immune compromised or undergoing treatment that would make them more susceptible to TB disease - To screen people less than 65 years of age prior to admission to long term care home. Facilities will need to purchase any non-funded Tubersol directly from the manufacturer or from a local pharmacy.		
Zoster (Shingrix®) *2-dose immunization series <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Eligible for individuals 65-70 years of age - <u>Eligibility expanded to include those born 1949-1953 until 2024-12-31.</u> 		
Other – such as Td or high risk vaccines.		

Reminder: All cold chain failures (temperatures found outside of the 2° to 8°C range) must be reported immediately to the Grey Bruce Public Health nurse responsible for your facility. Until the efficacy of your vaccine has been determined by this nurse you must not administer any of this vaccine.
