- The Care Path Checklist tool is a 3 step checklist that helps to guide staff responses based on what a client has disclosed, and other information that has been gathered during an interaction. Staff responsibilities are also populated based on the selections made from the checklist, which can further help staff guide their discussion. The Checklist can also be used as a staff educational tool prior to the interactions.
